What is Redwood City International?

Redwood City International (RCI) is a member of Sister Cities International, an international, nonprofit organization promoting sister city relationships. RCI's mission is to promote international understanding through people-topeople diplomacy and advance cultural awareness in Redwood City. Our current sister cities are Zhuhai, China, Ciudad Guzmán, Mexico, and Colima, Mexico. We also have established a friendship city relationship with Qingyuan, China.

Current Activities

RCI activities include: hosting sister city delegations, interns and other visitors, visiting sister cities as ambassadors from Redwood City, and establishing cultural or educational exchanges of mutual interest. Local activities include: organizing and partnering to put on cultural festivals, educational forums and fundraising to support these efforts. Cultural festivals include: Lunar New Year Festival and Fiestas Patrias.

1980's	Early business ties between the Port of Redwood City and Port of Zhuhai, China.
1990	Redwood City International becomes a member of Sister Cities International though the partnership between a group of residents and the City of Redwood City.
1993	Zhuhai, China becomes Redwood City's first sister city.
1998	Colima, Mexico joins as a Redwood City sister city.
2013	Ciudad Guzmán, Mexico joins as a Redwood City sister city.
2015	Qingyuan, China becomes Redwood City's first friendship city.
Today	Activities between RCI and our sister and friendship cities continue to provide a strong

cultural and educational bond for

all participants.
